<input type="checkbox"/>	CORE VACCINE: Rabies Minimum age is 16 weeks. For a 3 year rabies vaccine, proof of previous Rabies vaccination is required. <i>California has seen cases of rabies in both domestic and wild animals and remains a rabies endemic state. All dogs are required by California law to have a rabies vaccine.</i>	\$15
<input type="checkbox"/>	CORE VACCINE: DA2PPv (Distemper, Parvo, Parainfluenza) <i>This is a must vaccine for every dog because canine distemper is a serious, highly contagious disease with a high death rate. All dogs should be protected. While commonly called canine distemper vaccination, DA2PPv is actually a combination of vaccines in one injection that will protect your pet from several serious diseases (Distemper, Parvo, & Parainfluenza).</i>	\$15
or <input type="checkbox"/>	OPTIONAL: DA2PP (Distemper, Parvo, Parainfluenza, with Leptospirosis) Recommended for younger dogs who spend a lot of time in the wild or wet areas. MUST receive booster vaccines within 3-4 weeks to be effective. <i>Leptospirosis is a disease in the environment carried in rats, wildlife, as well as domestic livestock. Leptospira is known to exist in standing water, dampness, and mud. The disease can be passed along to humans.</i>	\$15
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bordetella <i>The Bordetella vaccine is given to dogs that are frequently exposed to other dogs in boarding, daycare, dog parks, and training classes. The vaccine prevents kennel cough which is a highly contagious upper respiratory infection.</i>	\$15
ADDITIONAL TREATMENTS		
<input type="checkbox"/>	Dewormer Treatments <i>Worms are common and can cause gastrointestinal problems. Dogs should receive treatments as part of general wellness.</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pyrantel (Treats Roundworms. Can be picked up from exposure to wild animals and is recommended for puppies).	\$20
<input type="checkbox"/>	Praziquantel (Treats Tapeworms. These worms look like rice grains in droppings and are carried by fleas).	\$20
<input type="checkbox"/>	Heartworm - Test Only <i>Heartworm disease is transmitted via mosquitos. All dogs not on heartworm prevention are susceptible and must be tested prior to starting prevention medication.</i>	\$20
<input type="checkbox"/>	Heartworm Prevention (only available once heartworm test is negative) <i>The American Heartworm Society recommends that all dogs be placed on year round heartworm prevention.</i>	
	<input type="checkbox"/> Puppies only: One (1) Month Supply, based on weight:	\$8-12
	<input type="checkbox"/> Adult dogs: Twelve (12) Month Supply, based on weight:	\$16-24
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flea Prevention - Oral medication. Not to be administered if dog has a history of seizures. <i>Monthly flea prevention is critical to prevent infestations and minimize disease and/or skin conditions caused by fleas.</i>	
	<input type="checkbox"/> One (1) Month - Single Dose, based on weight:	\$10-18
	<input type="checkbox"/> Six (6) to Twelve (12) Month Supply, based on weight:	\$50-160

- The clinic begins 9 AM and will serve the first 30 pets. Be prepared to wait up to 2 ½ hours for service.
- All dogs must be on leash; all cats must be in a carrier.
- Any animal that is visibly sick will not be vaccinated. Our medical team has the right to refuse service to any animal.
- We accept cash (no bills larger than \$20) and credit/debit cards only.
