<input type="checkbox"/>	CORE VACCINE: FVRCP (Panleukopenia, Upper Respiratory) <i>This core vaccination is a must for every cat. This means that, because panleukopenia (also known as feline distemper) is a serious, highly contagious disease with a high death rate, all cats should be protected. This vaccine also protects against other airborne viruses that cause respiratory infections.</i>	\$15
<input type="checkbox"/>	CORE VACCINE: Rabies Minumum age: 16 weeks. <i>California has seen cases of rabies in both domestic and wild animals and remains a rabies endemic state. All dogs are required by CA law to have a rabies vaccine, it is highly recommended for cats.</i>	\$15
ADDITIONAL TREATMENTS		
	Dewormer Treatments <i>Worms are common and can cause gastrointestinal problems. Dogs should receive treatments as part of general wellness.</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pyrantel (Treats Roundworms. Can be picked up from hunting outside and is recommended for young cats).	\$20
<input type="checkbox"/>	Praziquantel (Treats Tapeworms. These worms look like rice grains in droppings and are carried by fleas).	\$20
<input type="checkbox"/>	FIV/FelV Combo Test <i>A test for feline immunodeficiency virus (FIV) and feline leukemia (FeLV). FIV can compromise a cat's immune system and leave them vulnerable to other diseases and illness. FeLV is a contagious disease that results in death.</i>	\$20
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flea Prevention <i>Monthly flea prevention is critical to prevent infestations and minimize disease and/or skin conditions caused by the common flea.</i>	
	<input type="checkbox"/> One (1) Month - Single Dose, based on weight:	\$15-20
	<input type="checkbox"/> Six (6) to Twelve (12) Month Supply, based on weight:	\$80-180
